Chief Martin expressed his concern to the Board over the impact of a recent court decision removing the ability of an animal protection agency to enforce animal welfare laws. The Ontario Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) and Humane Society will no longer be permitted to provide enforcement services as of March 31, 2019. An initial estimate is that this decision will add about 350 calls each year to the Service workload.
